WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri Srinivas Bobbili presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring

- (i) the action of the Respondents 2 & 3 in rejecting the Petitioner's bid submitted for Sector-VII of Kamareddy District under the Tender Form bearing e-tender Reference No.Lr.No.225/DMP/KMR/PTC/KMS 25-26/KMS 26-27 dt.25/02/2026 vide whatsapp Message dt.18/03/2026 and also
- (ii) declaring the New Tender Notice dt.13/3/2026, as illegal, unjust, arbitrary, irrational, without jurisdiction, violative of Principles of Natural Justice, suffers from colourable exercise of power and in violation of Articles 14, 19 & 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the New Tender Notice dt.13/3/2026 to the extent of Sector-VII and direct the Respondents to treat the Petitioner's technical bid under the Tender Notice dt 25.02.2026 as

valid and appoint it as transport contractor for Sector-VII if she becomes L1 under the said tender process;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri L. Ravi Chander, Senior Counsel representing Sri Srinivas Bobbili, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

No.Lr.No.225/DMP/KMR/PTC/KMS 25-26/KMS 26-27 dt.25/02/2026 is bereft of reasons, and duly considering the view of the Apex Court in the judgment reported in (2010) 9 SCC 496 in "Kranthi Associates Private Limited and another Vs. Masood Ahmed Khan and others, there shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the Re-tender bearing e-Tender Reference No. Lr. No. 225/DMP/KMR/PTC /KMS 25-26/KMS 26-27 dated 13.03.2026, issued by Respondent Nos.2 and 3, to the extent of Sector-VII of Kamareddy District, till 26.03.2026.
